



Addendum #2 **Issued April 24, 2019**

Residential Single Stream Recyclables Collection and/or **Processing Services**

1. **Question:** If funds run out, can the SWDA terminate contract with 30 day notice.

Response: Yes, RFP language for section 2.26 is changed to the following in an effort to work with the Contractor (Section in yellow is the change);

2.26 TERMINATION

The SWDA reserves the right to terminate, without cause, any award made as a result of RFP by providing a thirty (30) day letter of cancellation notification to the successful Proposer.

Termination for convenience may entitle the contractor to receive payment for reasonable costs applicable to the contract for work or costs incurred by the contractor. The SWDA will reimburse on an amortized basis any reasonable expenditures incurred, not otherwise useful to the contractor or recoverable, such as capital outlay, rolling stock and lease termination expenses, subject to terms to be negotiated prior to execution of the Contract. Proposers should identify reimbursement expectations in their proposal.

2. **Question :** Please provide draft contracts for collection and processing.

Clarification of Question #11 in Addendum #1: Will there be a fee to dump at the Transfer Station?

Response: The collection Contractor will not be charged a tip fee at the transload facility or MRF. *Additional clarification:* Processing fees will be paid to the Awarded processing contractor by SWDA.
